Joe Sobieralski, president and CEO of Battle Creek Unlimited, said, "We are happy to partner with another Real Estate Improvement Fund recipient devoted to improving such a recognizable property in downtown Battle Creek. The first phase will focus on fixing the roof.

"With different square-footage possibilities, facility upgrades to the ground floor will make way for a variety of commercial tenants," Sobieralski added. "The upstairs housing component is a great fit, too, as more consumers look to live in a downtown, walkable setting."
